The meeting was called to order by Laura Curran at 9:00

Minutes – Amy Day

The March 2, 2022 Board Meeting Minutes were approved

Treasurer's Report – Laura Curran stated that our insurance policy started April 1, 2022

Membership – Jean Czubin

- There are 16 new members
- 11 were at the new members meeting and 3 will meet Thursday to go over the booklet
- 60 are signed up for welcome back breakfast

Handicap / Scoring / Day's Play – Diane Meyers

- There are 94 CWGA members in the GHIN system
- Sent out sheets though Golf Genius for 4/7 play
- Scramble is not a postable score
- Recommendation that Diane clarifies what scramble is, as there is some confusion
- There are 56 playing in the scramble, at \$5 each that gives us \$280 prize money. There will be a payout to 5 places, in the form of club house credits

- There was a problem with the website, however it was a Google issue
- We need to upgrade our site
- The 9er's and the CMGA have already upgraded their sites
- There will be a proposal to the CWGA Board to upgrade the CWGA site later this year

Eclectic/ Hole in One – Laura Noffke

- Cards are made up and ready to go
- If a score is not postable (i.e.: scrambles / Tuesday casual play) cannot be posted to eclectic either
- Cards will be near the score card box in the tent

- (At some point we will have a cabinet near Chris' office as will the other two golf groups)

Rules – Joann Linville

- Went over rules with new members
- There is a rules article in the Villager
- Reminder that on Tuesday golf, balls must be holed, no picking up if member plans to post the score
- Joann will mention that at 4/7 breakfast
- Suggestion was made that rule be added to the CWGA booklet
- Once a month at general meeting one rule will be discussed (2-5 minutes)
- To speed up pace of play, when putting, if member is close to hole, should just finish
- Members should post all scores from 3/1 on
- On the course, if somebody asks for, or gives advice, that is a penalty, but there is no penalty when asking about a RULE, as rules are public knowledge
- Joann will pick up some additional rule books from OGA

Social / Catering - Laurie Bales

- Lunch for May will have Cinco De Mayo theme. Cost will be \$19 which will include an 18% gratuity.

- A suggestion was made that all lunches and games are charged the same way. It was determined that a separate meeting take place, outside of the Board meeting, to establish a common process for monthly luncheons now that we do not have an area to post this information
- Those in charge of monthly social will decide if there is going to be a 50/50 drawing
- Vice Presidents of the CWGA are in charge of overseeing the socials and will step in as needed
- The binder to sign up for lunch and games will be in the pro shop

CWGA Director for CGC BOD – Laura Curran (for Terry Borst)

- There will be video poker where the club room is presently, primarily to generate revenue
- We will have a locked drawer and a cabinet in the clubhouse
- For now, money that is collected will be in the pro shop behind the counter

CGC Green and Golf Liaison – Rose Mason

- On the Red Course new red tees were being installed. Some of the ladies are unhappy that they are too far forward, so they are on hold for now
- They are sanding all three courses
- Club still looking for new assistant pro and assistant superintendent

- The Market Café should be done by the end of April
- CGC is trying to find a way to keep non golfers off the course, however there are 67 entrances to the courses so it is not a simple issue
- CGC asks if you have any questions about the courses that you, please go through the committee
