## STANDING RULES

The following Standing Rules are CWGA procedures.

- 1. Entry fees may be charged for competitions and events.
- 2. Play will be in flights as entries warrant.
- 3. Participants in Special Events or any major competitions must have established USGA Handicap Index.
- 4. Participants in Day's Play may play without an established Handicap Index providing they are in the process of acquiring one.
- 5. To acquire a USGA Handicap Index you must present three most recent attested 18-hole scorecards or six (6) 9-hole scorecards.
- 6. For players submitting their first scores to obtain an initial Handicap Index, the maximum score for each hole played is limited to par plus five strokes. (Handicap rule 3.1)
- 7. All members playing in the 18-hole competitions must have an established USGA Handicap Index.
- 8. All members will play to no more than a 37 Course Handicap, although they may maintain a higher Handicap Index.
- 9. The Scoring Committee will post your scores on Play Days.
- 10. Handicap Indexes and Course Handicaps at the beginning of a competition shall remain in effect throughout the competitions.

A requirement for play in the annual Club Championship is a minimum of eight (8) 18-hole rounds or sixteen (16) 9-hole rounds posted to GHIN that have been played with CWGA in the selected game of the day on Play Days. This includes competition days during the calendar year prior to the Club Championship competition. This round requirement is the same for Most Improved player.
