Treasurer's Report – Debbie Bray/Judy Wilcox

- Income year-to-date is greater than expected. This increase is because of the 119 membership and by charging \$5.00 for directories, our income is ahead of budget by approximately \$2000

- 4 new players have been added to GHIN. All have completed and updated their GHIN profile
- 117 members have been entered into GHIN
- 119 players are entered in Golf Genius
- CWGA Golf Club Handicapping Policies & Procedures effective June 7, 2023 was presented to the board. Dates of the following Competitions were listed: Partners Competition, (June 15,2023) Handicap Competition (Round 1 July 13, 2023; Round 2 July 14, 2023) and Club Championship (Round 1 September 15, 2023; Round 2 September16, 2023) The Board will vote on this document at the July 5, 2023 Board Meeting
- Our May Scramble was canceled due to lightning and rain (60 players had signed up)
- Tuesday's Day's Play has had a total of 220 players
- Thursday's Day's Play has had a total of 281 players
- Pay out total to date: \$1027.97
