Minutes – Marikate Book

The July 5, 2023 minutes were approved.

Men's Invitational – Kathy Harp and Jan Landis

- Volunteers and back-up volunteers are in place and ready to do their assigned jobs for the tournament
- Volunteers were reminded to wear their CWGA shirts, white or black shorts or slacks and their name tags
- Volunteers were invited to attend the cocktail party that will be held Thursday, August 3, 4:30-6:30 p.m.
- Revenue to our club will be \$1,000 minimum. Costs of the cocktail party will determine our total profit

Treasurer's Report – Debbie Bray/Judy Wilcox

- Current Balance \$9,057.61
- Membership 122
- Billing from the Market Café has been prompt
- Day's Play and Scramble posting is current and correct
- Charbonneau "Information Day" will be held September 6, 2023. CWGA will contribute a \$25.00 gift card from the Charbonneau Pro Shop. This expense will be reflected in the September budget
- Money earned from the Men's Club Invitational will determine if we commit \$1,500 or a lesser amount of money to our club's Stagette year end celebration

Membership – Jean Czubin (Marikate Book reported)

- Jean Czubin and Marikate Book will represent CWGA at Charbonneau's Information Day on September 6, 2024, 4:00-6:00 p.m.
- Jean Czubin, Marikate Book, Debbie Bray, Diane Myers, and Mary Jane Hunt met July 24, 2023 to revise our club's Membership Application. The revised application was presented under New Business

Handicap/ Scoring / Day's Play - Diane Meyers

- We have 122 players, 4 have not earned their HC Index, 34 players have improved their HC Index, 16 of those players have qualified for Most Improved player
- Approximately 80 players will qualify for the Championship Tournament. 2 players, playing strictly 9 holes have qualified. There are 4 Thursdays and 5 Tuesdays left to qualify for the Championship
- Tuesday play 523 players. Thursday play 571 players.
- Due to heavy participation on Thursdays and Scrambles, there was concern that the original amount of money budgeted for Pay-Outs was insufficient. (571 Players to date on Thursdays with \$2,242.47 in payouts, leaving \$757.53)
- Our treasury has sufficient funds to continue to pay for the rest of the season. It was decided that pay-outs will continue at the present rate
- Scoring managers need score cards turned in ASAP after completing play. Players will be reminded to not delay turning in their score cards
- Pace of Play will be addressed at the August 10, 2024 Scramble/General Meeting. Players will be reminded:
 - o Keep up with the group in front of you. You should be able to see them
 - Play Ready Golf! (a list of what that entails will be distributed in a Hand-Out at the August 10, 2023 Scramble/General Meeting)
 - Do not wait for everyone in the foursome to putt out, 2 can be moving to the next tee box
- Suggestions were made on how to ensure new members are introduced to our rigorous standard of Pace of Play:
 - An experienced player will assume the role of "Captain" for each foursome, or threesome, to encourage appropriate pace of play
 - Arrange for higher HC players to have later tee times, following experienced golfers
 - A course marshal to move players along
 - Educational workshops for teaching what can increase speed of play. (Possibly at a winter luncheon)
