Welcome to the 2024 OGA Women's Interclub Play Season

The OGA Women's Interclub Play (WIP) program is a Women's only interclub four-ball match play competition that will span a designated season within geographic regions served by the Oregon Golf Association. Regions will encompass at least two divisions of teams that will compete amongst their division playing for points. At the end of the Regular season, the division point winners will compete for an OGA Women's Interclub Championship.

Format: Two Person four-ball match play for points. The two players on the team play their own ball. The better ball of the two competes against the better ball of the opponent for win of the hole (gross or net). Points will be awarded for one gross and one net point for each hole, with half points awarded for any halved holes.

Our Charbonneau Team is in the Portland Region. Play: 3rd Monday of the month.

We will play a Match Play format. 4 Ball Match Play 3 matches (6 people, teams of 2) each month (best score of your team of 2 for gross and net for each hole)) 5 teams in each Division

Carts available. Captain Peg Wells will reserve carts.

Mobile App electronic scoring is used.

The App's scorecard will indicate which holes you will have pops on.

Each team will enter each person's score on the Mobile App at the end of each hole (It will automatically convert who has won the hole Gross and Net.)

You keep scores on a card as back up. At the end you review the scores entered to ensure they are correct.
