CWGA Championship Tournament 2025

Tuesday & Thursday, August 26 & 28 (Must play both days) 2-day Stroke Play

BE SURE YOU QUALIFY TO PLAY IN THE CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP, AUGUST 26 and 28

A requirement of play in the annual Club Championship is a minimum of eight (8) 18-hole rounds or sixteen (16) 9-holes round posted to GHIN that have been played with CWGA in the selected game of the day on Play Days. This includes competition days during the calendar year prior to the Club Championship competition.

There are only a few Play Days left to qualify for the Club Championship. To see if you have qualified, go to our website golfcwga.com click Day's Play & Results > Choose 9- or 18-Hole Results > Players Statistics > Player League Standings.

Players need to look for their Participant Points (shown as Part. Points on the chart) or Total Points. Players looking at 9-Hole Play will need to divide their Part. Points or Total Points in half for their total.

Requirement: 8 points for 18-holes and 16 points for 9-holes, or a combination equal to 8 for 18-holes.

Sign-Up: Golf Genius will be sent August 19th

Registration closes: Saturday, August 23rd

Entry Fee \$5.00 per person – Collected Day of Play(Tuesday)

<u>Game Format:</u> This is a two day stroke play competition. Player's scores will be combined for their two-day total score. Club Championship will be awarded to the overall low gross score of the field. Additional payouts will be in flights according to the number of participants, paying low gross and net. In the event of a tie for the overall Champion, a playoff will take place at approximately 2 p.m. In the event of ties in flights, USGA card-off recommendations will apply. CWGA has set a maximum course handicap of 37 for days play and competitions, even though your handicap may be higher.

Play will be as follows:

- 1. Check in with tournament starter 5 minutes before assigned tee time.
- 2. Exchange scorecards and keep a backup.
- 3. Drop zones will be in play and may be used as needed.
- 4. Maximum score, local rule of 9 strokes will **NOT** be used in competition.
- 5. At the end of each days play, return scorecards to scoring table to ensure any rules issues are resolved BEFORE scorecards are signed and attested.
- 6. Do not post. Posting will be done by the Golf Genius Manager.
- 7. A playoff will occur if there is a tie for the overall Champion

Final Decisions on Disputed Points will be made by the Tournament Committee, Rules Committee (if available) and Head or Assistant Golf Professional.
