

## 2026 Day's Play Procedures

**Tuesdays:** Members may select their own playing partners. This provides an opportunity to play with others who have similar handicaps and preferences. Players may also allow Golf Genius to randomly create the pairings. Payouts are awarded to 30% of the field on the first Tuesday of the month, and we retain ties.

**Thursdays:** Foursomes are set randomly by Golf Genius to allow members to play with a variety of players throughout the year and to ensure equitable distribution of tee times. Payouts are awarded to 30% of the field.

### Sign-Up Process for Day's Play Golf on Tuesdays & Thursdays

- **Invitations:** Seven (7) days before each Day's Play, the Manager will email a Golf Genius invitation for both 18-hole and 9-hole play. Deadline to sign up for Tuesday is Noon on Saturday. Deadline to sign up for Thursday is Noon on Monday
- **Registration:** Select "Playing" for either 18 or 9 holes and confirm. To decline, select "Not Playing," or ignore the invitation.
- **Changes or Cancellations:**
  - **Before Day of Play:** Contact the Day's Play Manager to cancel or to be added to the tee sheet.
  - **Day of Play:** Contact the Pro Shop for cancellations or to request a tee time if available. Tee times cannot be changed.
  - Players who cancel must notify their foursome.
- **Weather:** Arrive early and be prepared for possible tee time adjustments.
- **Managers:** Find the Day's Play Manager list at [golfcwga.com](http://golfcwga.com) under Play Results.
- **Scoring:** The Day's Play Manager will enter scores into Golf Genius and post to GHIN. Results will appear on the CWGA website leaderboard.

### Day of Play

#### Before Teeing Off

- Check in at the Pro Shop at least 20 minutes before your tee time.
- Print your Last and First Name on the scorecard.
- Arrive at the tee box five (5) minutes before your tee time.
- Exchange scorecards with your playing partners.

#### After the Round

- Record your gross score only on each hole and total after each nine.
- Ensure your scorecard is signed, attested, and dated.
- If you do not finish your round, write DNF on your card.
- Return all scorecards to the Pro Shop. Cards collected by the Day's Play Manager are the official record.
- Scores posted to GHIN on Day's Play count toward Club Championship and Most Improved Player eligibility.
- Unsigned scorecards will be posted with a two-stroke penalty on the last hole played and are not eligible for payouts (per Handicap Rule 2.1b, Rule of Golf 3.3b).
