Days Play/Scoring – Patti Book

- 71 members are currently signed up for Winter Golf.
- A reminder that scores must be entered hole-by-hole in the GHIN app beginning March 1 is included on the tee sheet.
- 113 members signed up for Winter Golf in February (52 Tuesday / 51 Thursday). These are sign-up figures rather than actual play totals; participation varies with weather conditions.
- On February 17, the CWGA Scoring Committee (Patti Book, Karen Miller, Lynne McMaster) met with representatives of the Men's Club and Niners to standardize procedures for the 2026 season. Key agreements include:
 - o Golf Genius invitations will open 7 days prior and close 3 days prior at noon (Battle of the Sexes: open 3 weeks prior, close 1 week prior).
 - o The Pro Shop will refer cancellation or addition requests to the Day's Play Manager prior to the day of play.
 - o The Pro Shop will not reschedule tee times for players who cancel.
 - o When space is available, the Pro Shop may add players who missed signup or whose plans changed.
 - o The 2026 Day's Play Manager schedule, contact information, and calendar have been provided to the Pro Shop and posted.
- Due to reductions in the Member Handbook, additional Day's Play procedures are being prepared for posting on the website.
 - All CWGA members will re-register in Golf Genius to access the Day's Play Portal. A successful Board test run was completed, and member instructions will be sent next week. Registration is only required to access the portal (tee sheets and results) and will not affect receiving invitations to play.
 - The Day's Play Managers meeting is scheduled for March 16 to review updates and procedures

Old Business:

Membership Book – Alice Galloway

- Sharon Kadell suggested using Graphic Expressions for printing. The cost was half of last year's price. The 2026 book has 40 pages and a pale pink cover, at a cost of \$2.70 per book. Alice has ordered 140 books for a cost of \$375. This year, \$1,000 was budgeted, as we paid almost \$900 last year.
- The book is at the printers. At this point, new members will only be on the website.
- Discussion regarding the need for the website roster and membership book followed. The roster is easier to use with the alphabetical selection. Many liked having the two options available.

Battle of Sexes – Coleen Larson

- This fundraiser is scheduled for August 6th with a \$20 entry fee. Chris Bensel has agreed that the golf course will provide lunch at no cost.
- Golf Genius will organize teams. Members will play 18 holes. Four CWGA women will play together, followed by four Men's Club members. The game will be matchplay. This group of eight will be seated at the same table for lunch.
- We will need to stress "No gimmies", and each player must putt out.
- Tricia Smith will organize a money board to do at lunch to raise more funds.
- All funds will go to the Merit Awards.

New Business:
