

Handicap

All CWGA members must have established a USGA Handicap Index. Handicaps are updated daily at midnight. The Maximum Charbonneau Course Handicap is 37. When a 9-hole or 10–17-hole score is posted, the World Handicap System (WHS) automatically calculates an 18-hole Score Differential. Members are encouraged to post scores hole by hole to ensure accuracy when playing outside of scheduled CWGA Tuesday and Thursday play. Day's Play Managers post scores for CWGA Day's Play on Tuesday and Thursday.

Purpose of Day's Play, Scrambles, and Competitions

The purpose of Day's Play, Scrambles, and Competitions is to support and uphold the objectives of CWGA as documented in the By-Laws. These activities are designed to:

- Govern amateur golf within CWGA in accordance with the Rules of Golf adopted by the United States Golf Association.
- Ensure compliance with the rules and regulations of Charbonneau Golf Club, Inc.
- Maintain the integrity of the USGA Handicap System, ensuring every member has a fair and equitable opportunity to compete.
- Promote the game of golf by encouraging friendly competition, true sportsmanship, and meaningful fellowship among members.

We expect—and enthusiastically require—all players to follow USGA and Charbonneau Golf Club rules and regulations to help preserve the spirit and fairness of the game.

Formats and Pairings

Tuesday Day's Play

On Tuesdays, members may choose their playing partners or allow Golf Genius to pair them. This option allows golfers to group with friends and/or players with similar handicaps while enjoying a comfortable and competitive round. Payouts are awarded to 30% of the field, only on the first Tuesday of the month.

Thursday Day's Play

On Thursdays, Golf Genius creates pairings randomly to provide members with opportunities to play with a variety of CWGA members throughout the year. This approach also helps distribute tee times fairly and provide opportunities to meet other CWGA members that players may not have other contact with. Payouts on all Thursdays are awarded to 30% of the field.

Scrambles

For Scrambles, Golf Genius creates foursomes that include one player from each of the four levels (Flights). This balanced structure ensures that every team has a fair and equal chance to compete.

Competitions

Our three competitions, Partners, Handicap and Club Championship, are two-day tournaments. To participate in the Club Championship, you must have played eight 18-hole rounds or 16 9-hole rounds, or a combination to reach the eight 18-hole minimum,

with CWGA. Payouts are awarded to the overall winner and to the top 30% of the field within levels (Flights), Net, and Gross divisions.

Special Awards

Most Improved Golfer and Home and Away Hole-In One are two awards determined at the end of each season.

Winnings

All winnings are credited to members' Pro Shop accounts, which must be spent by December 31st. Results are posted through the portal to Golf Genius, accessible on the CWGA website.

Rules

CWGA Standing and Local Rules, as well as all USGA Rules are in force for all Day's Play and Competitions unless modified by notices to the players. All CWGA Standing and Local Rules are posted on the CWGA website. **Members should review our club-specific rules prior to the beginning of our golf season.
